

Kemtile at Shepherd Neame

Kemtile Limited, who have over 25 years experience supplying hygienic floor and wall finishes to the food, drink and pharmaceutical industries, installed the flooring system during a three week period in which the hall was empty. Once the floor was laid the tanks were lowered in through the roof.



The floor consisted of 350 square metres of Pilkingtons’ Dorset Hexagon in Grey Steel with Stipple R11 profile for slip resistance. Dorset Hexagon is a new addition Pilkingtons’ Dorset Floor Tile range and this is the first project on which it has been used.

The tiles were installed using the Kagetec GFK system which is ideal for very wet areas due to its totally impervious substrate.

In addition Kemtile supplied stainless steel drainage channel and border and skirting tiles in Dark Grey as well as expansion joints which were reinforced with stainless steel angle to reduce the possibility of damage being done by trucking.

Ian Dixon, Production Manager at Shepherd Neame, told us, “This is

the third time we have used Kemtile for our chemical resistant flooring. As always they have given us excellent service and we have recommended them subsequently to others.”

NOTES TO EDITORS

2. Dorset Hexagon from Pilkintons Tiles Group Plc is a new addition to the Dorset Woolliscroft Atlaz Floor Tile range and this is the first project on which it has been used

The hexagonal shape is ideally suited for dishing to falls around gullies, which make them ideal in manufacturing environments where regular wash downs are required. When laid the evidence of the perpendicular lines are not obvious. They are specifically designed to be laid by the vibration method.

The tiles are available in four colours which match the existing square and rectangular tiles in Pilkington's popular Atlaz range; Grey Steel, Sandstorm, Savanna and Dark Grey. There are two slip resistant textures Granular R13 and Stipple R11. The range is available with matching coves and fittings.

3. Kemtile is the exclusive UK applicator for Kagetec Tiling Systems engineered in Germany by Von Koetsveld and Grimberg GmbH Specifically for use in demanding environments. All five systems produce a similar hygienic finish with flush filled 2mm wide joints. They can be used with specially designed hexagon or rectangular tiles.
